POLICY NAME: Boulevard Maintenance

PURPOSE OF THE BOULEVARD MAINTENANCE POLICY

The purpose of the policy is to ensure fair and equitable treatment for those who, by choice park on public boulevards to those who maintain private driveways.


DEFINITIONS:

- 1.0 **Boulevard** is that portion of land between privately owned property and public thoroughfares.
- 2.0 **Vehicles** refers to any and all vehicles that are permitted to be parked on public thoroughfares in accordance with Bylaw #498-0810, Traffic Control and amendments thereto.
- 3.0 **Parking** refers to the site where residents normally leave their vehicles when not in use.
- 3.0 **Applicability**
This policy applies to all residents and organizations and businesses within the Village of Elnora.
It does not apply to home based businesses who have a valid development and a current business license.
- 4.0 **Procedures**
Residents who have no private driveway access to their property and choose to park on the boulevard adjacent to their property, owned or rented:
 - 5.1 Residents are responsible for the seasonal maintenance costs of that boulevard:
 - Gravel – May be purchased from the Village at the recovery cost as listed in the current Rates Bylaw;
 - Snow Removal – Residents are responsible for arrangement and cost of snow removal from their boulevard to enable private parking. This service is available from local vendors, the Village cannot provide snow removal to boulevards utilized as personal parking spaces.


5.0 This policy shall be reviewed every two (2) years.
